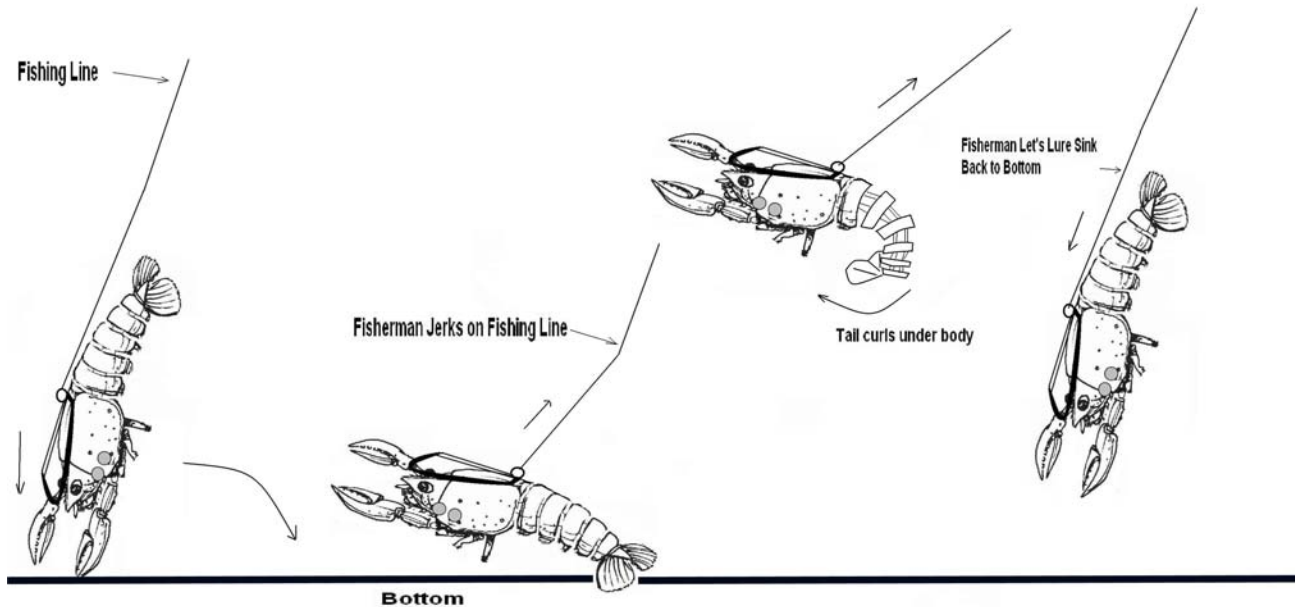




Product Bulletin – Model # EG-113 Flex Crawfish

The new Flex Crawfish jig is a unique fishing lure used primarily for flipping, pitching, and jigging for Bass. The lure is unique in that it is a hard plastic jig that looks and acts like a crawfish, one of the favorite prey of Bass. The action is illustrated here:

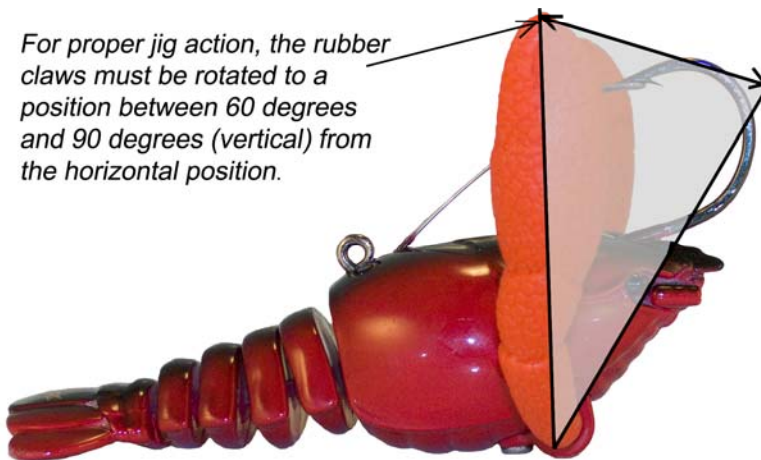


As with soft plastic jigs and worms, proper rigging of the Flex Crawfish is essential to get the proper action:



When the Flex Crawfish comes out of the package, the rubber claws are in a horizontal position. Fishing with the Flex Crawfish with the claws in this position will cause the jig to fall improperly, landing upside down or on its side.

For proper jig action, the rubber claws must be rotated to a position between 60 degrees and 90 degrees (vertical) from the horizontal position.



To get the proper jigging action, the rubber claws must be rotated to a position between 60° and 90° from horizontal. **FAILURE TO MOVE THE CLAWS INTO THIS POSITION WILL CAUSE THE JIG TO NOT WORK AS DESIGNED.** Because the claws are made of soft rubber, they will move in a natural motion in the water, while the angler is working the jig.

To rotate the claws into the proper position, gently stretch the claws away from the body of the lure. As the rubber stretches, it will become thinner. Using your fingers, rotate the claws into the proper position. There is no need to remove the screw holding the claws onto the body. While fishing, re-adjust the claws as needed after catching those trophy Bass.
